With the Total School Cluster Group model being employed at Oak Hill, school administration and SLT are ensuring that heterogeneous classrooms based on performance, race, gender, disability, and ethnicity are monitored and implemented.

Process:

Enrichment for kindergarten through fifth grade in TDAS and Math with intentional integration and access to technology for real world learning.

Licensed staff are implementing Courageous Conversations at the staff level. During the 2020-21 school year, school administration and SLT will model racial biographies for small groups of staff members. Community members and organizers will be provide modeling of racial biographies to all staff.
