Guest Speakers

Caleb Dirckx, a 7^{th} grader from North Junior High. He is part of a group dedicated to community problem solving (After school activity at North). Last year they worked to improve intersection at 29^{th} and 12^{th} .

This year, Caleb is working on Project C.O.N.N.E.C.T. (Creating a SmOoth traNsition from elemeNtary to middle school studenTs) His goal is to help 5th graders transition to North by giving tours, having counselors speaking about student functions at North, and available activities for 6th grade. There will also be a panel of current students to answer questions. He also wants to host a picnic with Madison's PTA and North's PTO to help parents get involved. The enrichment activities available at Madison.

Knowledge Bowl – For 5^{th} grade only. One team is formed at the beginning of the year. This activity features three round of competitions at different schools in the district.

US Academic Triathlon - Three events involving working collaboration (mind sprints, face off, party in a box - 40 minutes to read a scenario and create a 5 minute skit to solve a problem). This activity is \$15 per student; scholarships are available. Transportation for events out of district is not covered so parents must provide it. Madison will host the regional event in March.

Spelling Bee – 4th& 5th grade. 5th graders can move on to district and state levels. Each class receives a list of 30 words to practice. A full spelling bee competition takes place at Madison. Two 5th grade students will move on to the district level.

Science Rocks – Hands on science and nature conference at St John's. 5th grade only, limited to 20 students and cost \$27 per student.

YAYA (Young Authors Young Artists) Conference – Held at St Ben's for 4^{th} and 5^{th} students who excel in writing and drawing. Limited to 20 students per grade and cost \$27 per student.

Word Masters & Math Masters – 3rd-5th Coming next year and challenges critical thinking skills.

Math League – Covers grade level topics, helps student enjoy math.

Geography Bee – Similar to spelling bee, sparks student interest in geography. Looking for financial help for students who can't afford to go and t-shirts.
