- **Highly recommend paying with Cash to get inside faster!**

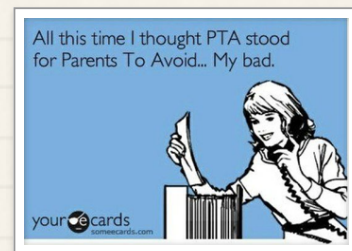

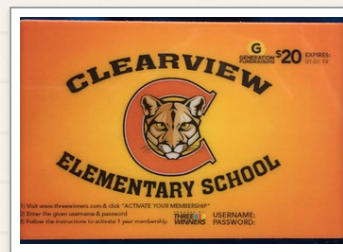
