CONSCIOUS DISCIPLINE BY DR. BECKY BAILEY

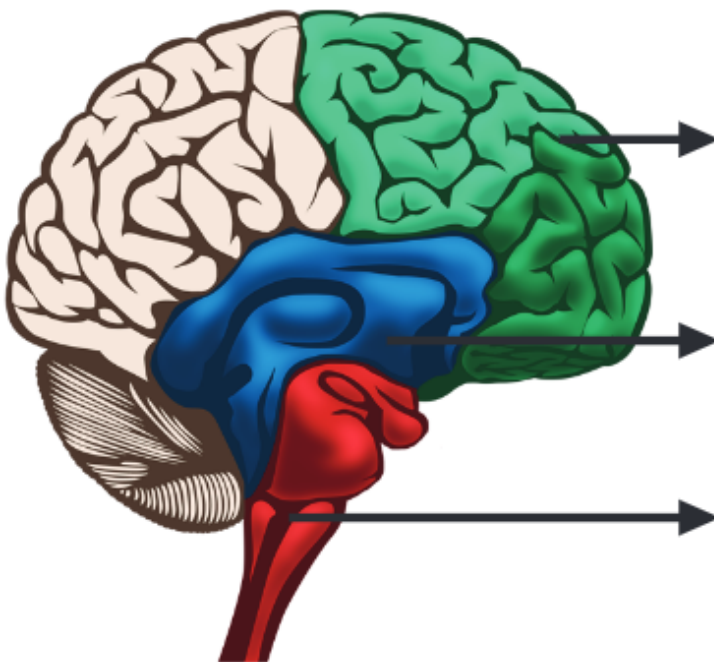
Parents might have noticed Brain State Posters in classrooms or hallways during conferences.
