Take a Break (classroom or hall)

- -Buddy Break
- -Social Conference with teacher
- -Re-teach positive behavior
- -Teacher calls **x0** to call behavior staff -If student has behavioral goals, student should go

to case manager

- -If behavior does not deescalate student should be taken to office or call behavior team -This will result in BS (behavior sheet) write up
- -Write ups will be put in Mr. Hansen's box to file

by teacher

## **Minor** Offense

- Blurting out
- Talking back
- Disruptions in class or hallway
- **Arguing**
- Incomplete work
- Not listening to an adult
- Irresponsible use of facilities
- Running in halls
- Teasing
- Cheating
- Play fighting
- Dress code
- Not taking a break
- Property misuse
- Other small behaviors which do not meet school rule expectations

## Major Offense

- Fighting/assault
- Racial/sexual behaviors/com ments
- Harassment
- Verbal disrespect towards Westwood student or staff members
- Stealing
- **Bullying threats**
- Weapons
- Vandalism
- Spitting on/at another person
- Abusive language
- Throwing food
- Interfering with the rights of others

-Teacher calls **x0** and states it is a major infraction -Teacher communicates

issue with behavior staff

- -Conference with behavior staff member -Replacement behavior, re-teach expectations, rehearse behavior -This will result in BS write up by teacher Write ups should be put in Mr. Hansen's box to file
- -Students will be referred to administration

**Every minor** – Teachers re-teach expectation

**3 minor-** Teachers contacts parents or guardians

**4-5 minors**-Refer to office

## **Serious Behaviors**

Including but not limited to:

- Destruction of property
- Physical assault
- Violation of school board policy; weapons policy, drug and tobacco policy, violence, harassment, & bullying policy
