Videography/ Photography Production Lab

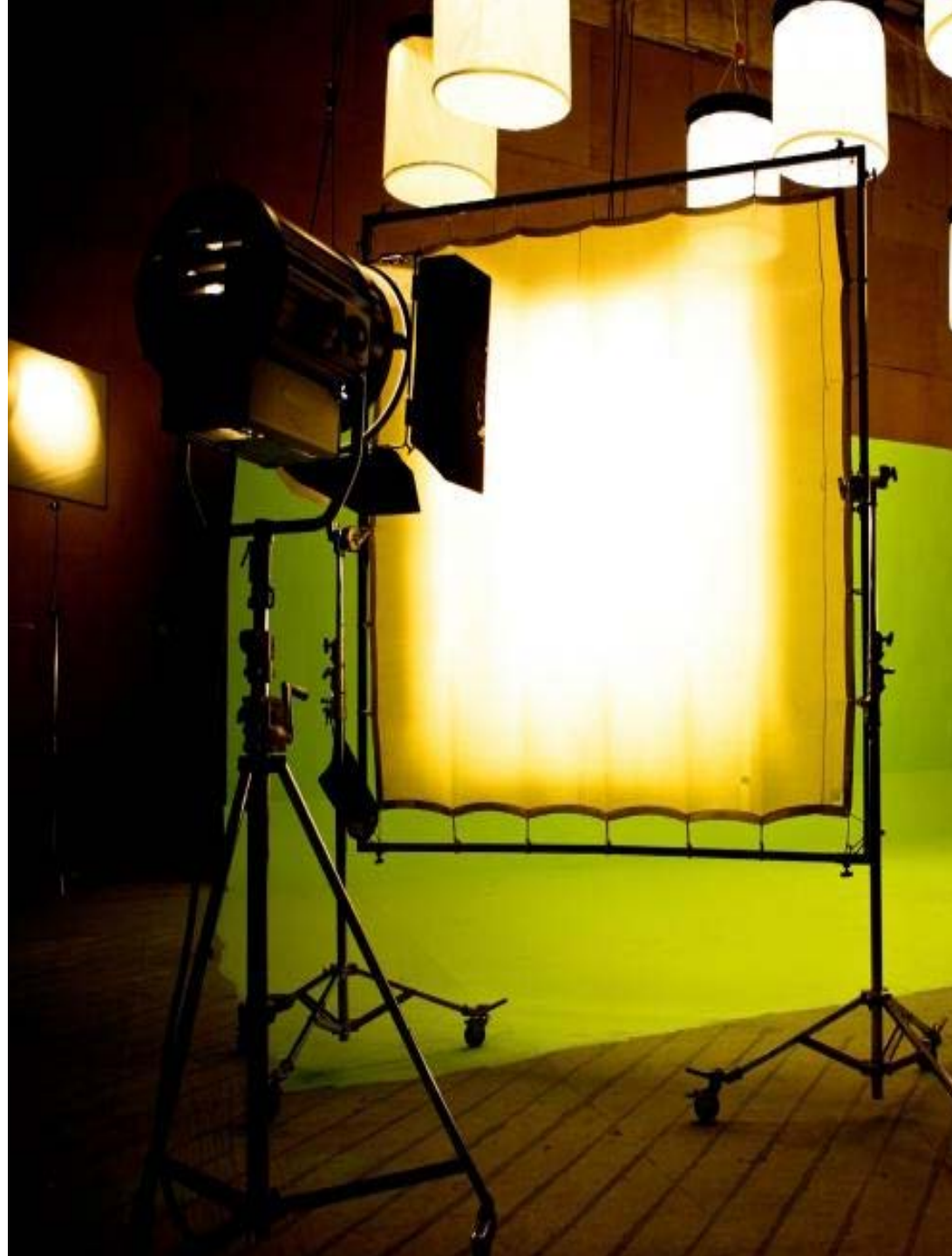
- 12-foot ceiling to accommodate lighting

Office Area (550 sq ft)

- Printing/print management
- Copying
- Website creation and upkeep
- Processing
- IT/computer (300 sq. ft)



**This area currently
occupies 850 sq ft.**

bumps up to 1,050 sq ft.



Media Storage

- Textbook storage (if not housed in the learning communities)
- Space needed to store 12,000 textbooks and language arts materials
- Macbook storage
- Space to store 1,500 Macbooks securely
- Space needed exclusively for four months out of the year
- Could be shared with Yearbook



**Textbook Storage
currently 1,600 sq ft.**

Macbook storage
currently 264 sq ft.

(hopefully enough to
store 700 Macbooks)

350 stored last summer



Media Storage

Shelving Needs

Textbook

- 2x4 by 6' high shelf can house approx 400 textbooks
- 30 units to house 12,000 books

Macbook

- 2x4 by 6' high shelf can house approximately 140 Macbooks in paper boxes
- 12 units to house 1,600 Macbooks

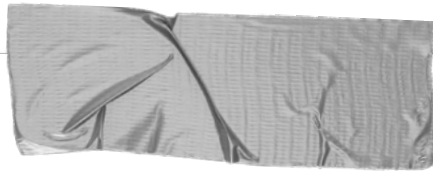

electronic)



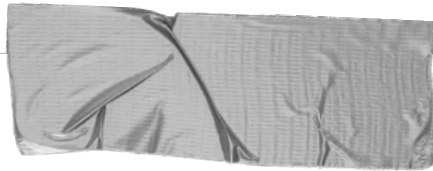


Not a Book Warehouse

 - E-readers, tablets, etc.

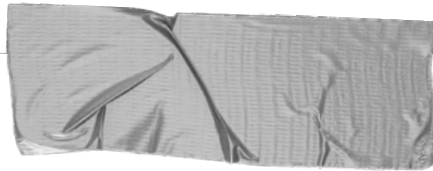




Infrastructure
