

# PARENT GUIDELINES

## For Virtual Learning



1.

Create a dedicated and consistent learning space for your scholar. Set up a quiet, clutter-free area.

2.

Reduce distractions. Be aware of activity in the home that could be distracting to the virtual learning environment.

3.

Respect your scholar's online time with teacher and classmates. Do not engage with your scholar's teacher or classmates during learning.

4.

Establish a schedule and support your scholar in being on time for virtual learning sessions.

5.

Do not photograph, record, videotape or distribute any portion of instructional sessions. \*



\* School policies prohibit photographing, recording, videotaping or distributing any portion of instructional sessions. This is due to the data privacy laws that apply to the learning environment. In addition, Minnesota's wiretapping statute states that it is illegal for a person to record a wire, oral, or electronic communication if that person is not a party to the communication. Accordingly, it is a violation of Minnesota law for a household member of a student to photograph, record, videotape or distribute any portion of the instructional session, since household members are not a party to the virtual session.
