College graduates typically have better access to health care than those with a high school diploma




WHY COLLEGE CONTINUES...

Knowledge: A college education teaches you to think critically and abstractly, to express your thoughts and opinions, to weigh options and make informed decisions.

<u>Potential:</u> College brings you a world of information as you explore your interests, and helps you understand the issues that connect communities, the nation and the world.

<u>Opportunity:</u> Critical thinking and new technology skills are vital for success and advancement in today's workforce and provide you with more career and job options.

<u>Income</u>: A person with a college certificate or degree (associate, bachelor's degree or higher) typically has a higher income and is less likely to be unemployed or underemployed than someone with a high school diploma.

Before you apply to college, you need to make a list of colleges that interest you and meet your needs. Here is a guide with suggestions on how to go about doing that.


General: Type of college, location, distance from home, size, etc.


Academic: Type of degree, majors, online v. inperson, etc.


Social: Housing options, student clubs, support services, student body, etc.
