A state and nationally recognized leader in innovative education, St. Cloud Area School District 742 has 896 teachers, 819 support staff and 74 members of the District Leadership team (principals, directors, supervisors, department heads and licensed coordinators) for a total of 1,788 full and part-time employees. District 742 is an affirmative action, equal opportunity employer. Sixty six percent of teachers have advanced degrees. District 742 offers an extensive staff development program, providing employees opportunities for support, growth and renewal.

Every classroom has one or more computers fully linked to the Internet, making classroom computers another tool in the delivery of instruction. District 742 is the 15<sup>th</sup> largest district in Minnesota serving a population of 100,303 people within 250 square miles (4 counties).
