School wide Tiered Fidelity Inventory (TFI)	PBIS Teams will take the Tier 1 section of the TFI	Teams who have met criteria (70%) will take the TFI as an annual assessment. PBIS & MTSS Teams will use the items reports to determine 1-3 actions teams can take to strengthen fidelity of implementation. The general guideline is to look for 1s and work to implement features that will move the 1 score to a 2 score.
		Teams who have not met criteria (70%) will take the TFI as a progress monitoring tool twice each year.	Teams who are using the TFI as a progress monitoring tool will take the TFI in October and March.	PBIS Teams will share results of the TFI and proposed action steps will Staff, Families and Students in a meaningful way for each group.
School teams are not required to take any other PBIS assessments but are welcome to do so if they think it will be helpful to their implementation efforts.	MTSS Teams will take the Tier 2 & Tier 3 Sections of the TFI	MTSS teams will take as a progress monitoring tool twice a year.	MTSS Teams will take the TFI in September and February.	MTSS Teams will share results and proposed action with staff in a meaningful way.
