Summer School is a credit recovery opportunity available to students in grades 9-12 who need to make up classes required for graduation. **Classes will be in-person at ALC-McKinley.** (However, if there are changes in COVID numbers, this learning model could potentially change.)

Priority Scale for Summer School 2021:

- 11-12th graders from Tech/Apollo (2021-2022 grads)
- 10th graders from Tech/Apollo (2023 grads)
- 9th graders from Tech/Apollo (2024 grads)
- Out of District Students (2021 grads only)

Forms are available on-line at isd742.org. To complete a **trimester** credit, students must attend daily and complete all assignments needed for course credit.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, we will continue to use the Schoology program for posting assignments. Students will need to know their Schoology login information and have a working laptop before they start June 7.

Summer school classes are scheduled as seat-based classes. Teachers are accessible Monday-Thursday from 8:00am-12:00pm. Classes will be one hour long (4 credits or 4 classes). Attendance is required to get credit for the class. Class credit is awarded when all assignments and assessments are completed.

PENDING DEMAND: We are also planning on providing an additional summer school session for 2020 & 2021 grads.
