Students capable of higher academic rigor participate in the Young Scholars program, developing problem-solving skills and showing critical thinking skills, while focusing on the process, not just the product.

Through AVID, students learn study habits, organizational skills, and develop critical thinking skills to make college access and success attainable. Advancement Via Individual Determination (AVID) systematically increases academic rigor and engaging learning environments.

Co-teaching is provided during reading instruction in all classrooms to meet the needs of diverse learners. Students benefit from collaborative teaching, rigorous content and language instruction.

Integrating Fine Arts & Movement
