  - Working with partners to reduce transportation barriers

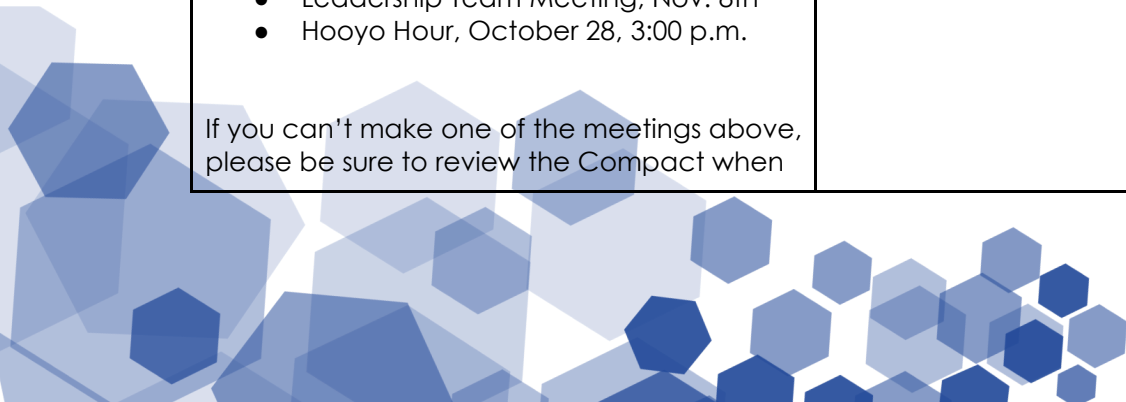
## COMMUNICATIONS
